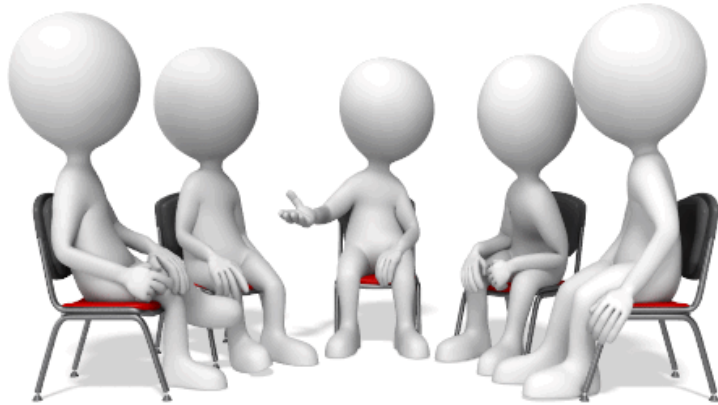


- WinS Program Implementation in BECS received 2nd Place in the division level and gained 2 star level in the TSA.
